






# **Diaper Circular Solution**












#### **Delivery and collection service**


- Monthly or annually subscription service offered by diaper companies. Service including delivering diapers to households and collecting used diapers at a weekly basis.
- Reduce excess production of hygiene products by collecting the data from customers monthly usage.
- => Shift diaper product to a hygiene service and reduce excess waste from managing the production amount.

## - Hydroponic planting: cultivating plants with the nutrition extracted from human waste of the diapers.

- Use the plastic, cellulose and super absorbent materials from diapers to make products for trees, such as tree wraps, fruit protection bags, and tree bandages.
- => Create value for used hygiene products and generate product that improve our environment.

## Our wish...

#### **Short term:**

- Offer a customer-centric service where parents no longer need to worry about buying, throwing and recycling diapers.
- Cooperate with local instant delivery companies to build the give-and-take recycle service, to make the best use out of the transportation.

### Long term:

- Recycle diapers for hydroponic planting and reproduce products used for plants.
- Contribute to our planet by planting 1 tree from every 100 recycled diapers.

If we can reach our goal of planting 1 tree every 100 diapers recycled => we could plant **over 200,000 trees every day**
